Back in Portpatrick with Dominic on the final boat of the season 8 club members headed out on a chilly morning started drifting for mackerel after couple drifts we had enough bait mainly 4inch mackerel.

Dropped anchor and Lsd coming in almost immediately Graeme then had a 12lb 8oz Bullhuss quickly followed by another of 14lb which was the heaviest fish of the day fishing very slow just Lsd and couple tub and grey gurnards John then had a 13 point Bullhuss I then had a spotted ray and 2 lsd on same drop Bullhuss coming in more frequently Bob and Daniel had 13 pointers myself and Pete had a 9 pointer each still more Lsd and a couple of whiting lifted anchor and headed inshore for some pollack fishing.



First cast I had 2 point fish John had a 4point pollack I then had 4lb 8oz pollack headed to the harbour mouth couple more pollack caught the headed home



I won the boat with 131 points John Keegan second 72 points and Graeme and Bob joint third 53 points. Total fish 95 and 7 species Whiting Spotted Ray Bullhuss Lsd Tub Gurnard Grey Gurnard and pollack.

Next boat is the first of the winter boats Oban/Etive on Sunday 6th October with Jack hope to see you all there.

Monthly Shore Report: Terally Bay

The Final outing of the season was held at the Terally Bay on Saturday 14th September 2014 fishing from Fishing 16:00hrs to 22:00hrs over low tide for Dogfish with a chance of a Bullhuss as this is where the Club record was caught.

Two club members attended the outing and met up and travelled down. After a short discussion they elected ed to fish at Myroch Point at the North end of the Bay in the hope of targeting some bull huss as this is where most had been captured previously, rather than the other end which tends to produce more dogfish. It was a fine evening to start with good conditions though a bit windy after the tail end of storm Dorian and another weather front was expected to blow in later in the evening. The previous week had churned up a lot of weed in the water and though it was a nice blue on the surface,



conditions below the waves were murky. It was a struggle to deal with the fine weed that accumulated on the line (like the stuff you get at Carsethorne) choking up rod rings and blocking shock leader knots. At least one set of gear was lost just due to the friction created at the rod tip!

Fishing was very slow until darkness and then picked up a little with some dogs being landed mainly by David who also managed to eek out a huss from the murky depths.
