SHORE CONVENER
Club Shore Championship August 2017

The Eleventh outing of the season was held at the Isle of Whithorn on Saturday 5th August 2017 fishing from 14:00hrs to 20:00hrs fishing three hours down and three hours up through low tide. The main target species was Lesser Spotted Dogfish Pollack and Wrasse with the chance of a Smoothhound fishing from the rocks.

Four club members attended the outing including and we met up at 11:00hrs to get loaded up into one car before travelling down together to the Isle of Whithorn and arrived at 13:30hrs. After getting out gear on we walked out onto the headland to find a perch on the rocks to fish from for the day. Once settled we began fishing with Dogfish coming in almost immediately to all anglers and a lovely Smoothhound of 6lb 12oz landed by Wullie Pollock on his first cast. The Dogfish were relentless in consuming almost any bait that was cast out so most anglers decided to try for Pollack and Wrasse for some variety.

Lesser Spotted Dogfish made up the bulk of the bags with some Pollack, Ballan Wrasse and Mackerel making up the rest. Gordon McFall finished with the heaviest bag and the chocolate with an 8oz Ballan Wrasse and Wullie Pollack had the heaviest fish with a 6lb 12oz Smoothhound.

The next outing will be at Ardwell on Saturday 16th September where wrasse and Pollack will be the main target.

Back in Portpatrick with Steve 5club members and 3 guest calm but overcast hoping for some spurs or tope headed towards Port Logan Pollacking fish coming regularly mostly 3-4 point Pollack with some Ballan Wrasse Ron had the biggest wrasse 2lb 14oz headed offshore couple of drifts produced some gurnard haddock and whiting and one 4 inch mackerel for guest Ian went to Logan wreck couple of drifts but not much Gordon had a 10lb Spurdog followed by guest Robert with one of 12lbs decided to anchor on the bank very soon spurs were coming in all the boat all double figure fish Steve served up sausage rolls and tea and coffee but had no time to relax netting all the spurs guest Ian had one of 15lb the fish were getting bigger when guest Robert hooked into a skate unfortunately after trying to move it off the bottom the line snapped. Lots of 13 pointers Gordon then had a couple of double doubles Ron had a 15lb and Ian was bitten off some L.s.d and gurnard and haddock Steve served up rolls and sausage still the fish came must have been huge shoal of spurs I ended up with 3 fish over club record size 15lb 10oz 17lb and 17lb 10oz great days fishing 121 countable fish over 60 double Spurdogs 9 species. Pollack, Ballan Wrasse, Whiting, L.s.d, Red Gurnard, Grey Gurnard, Haddock, Mackerel and Spurdog.

Ron won the boat with 220 points I was second with 193 points and Gordon third with 176 points guest Ian had the heaviest fish 20lb 10oz Spurdog. Thanks to our guest Ian, Robert and Craig also to skipper Steve who was run off his feet netting fish. .

Our next outing is the final boat of 2016/17 season Portpatrick on 17th September with Dominic hope to see you there
